www.thesafespace.org A fantastic and comprehensive resource for teens to learn about dating violence. The site contains many interactive components for teens. Everything is presented in a style that is very visually appealing. Also included are sections where teens can ask questions about dating violence and speak out about abuse.

www.loveisrespect.org Has great relationship themed quizzes, a Teen Handbook, Helpline, resource info, pocket quiz cards, and information on Teen Dating Violence and technology.

www.breakthecycle.org This site contains videos of teen survivors speaking about their experiences, a form you can submit to request a speaker, and a form to become a member of HOPE, a national membership program for people who want to speak out against teen dating violence. The site also includes a letter you can send to principals and legislators to demand they take action against abuse, and a DVD curriculum (which includes an educators guide) called *Ending Violence*, which is free for people working with teens in California.
